This question is based on question number 7, on page 153. In this question, and throughout the course, when I use the term *string*, I am referring to an **apstring**.

1. Write the function **declaration** for a function that takes four **apstrings** as parameters and returns an **apstring**. Name the function **JoinStrings**.
2. Implement the function **JoinStrings** so that it computes a new **apstring** that is the result of concatenating the four **apstring** parameters, using the ***** character to separate them. As an example, if the four parameters are "this", "is", "a", "test", then **JoinStrings** returns the new string that represents "this*is*a*test".
3. Write a **main** program, with any **#include** directives that you need, that prompts the user to enter four strings, reads the four strings, and then outputs the result of calling **JoinStrings** on those four strings.
